- Annually support Southside Medical Center, Sickle Cell Foundation, International Women's House, Hosea Feed the Hungry, MedShare International, Atlanta Community Food Bank and Susan G Komen since 2014.
- Regularly organize annual summer enrichment and educational programs for youth and children inthe Atlanta Metro area (WAZOBIA Sunfest)
- Conduct outreach to schools in the Metro Atlanta area to educate students about the cultural heritage of Nigeria and Africa.
- Provided support to Hurricane Katrina Victims, Carter Center Guinea Worm Eradication Program, Mercy Foundation, Haiti Earthquake Victims and American Cancer Society.
- Since 2008, NWAG volunteers annually at MedShare International. NWAG has also volunteered at
