- Awarded 60 one-time scholarships to qualified high school seniors in Atlanta, Georgia.
- Annually support **Southside Medical Center, Sickle Cell Foundation, International Women's House, Hosea Feed the Hungry, MedShare International, Atlanta Community Food Bank and Susan G Komen since 2014.**
- Regularly organize annual summer enrichment and educational programs for youth and children in the Atlanta Metro area (**WAZOBIA Sunfest**)
- Conduct outreach to schools in the Metro Atlanta area to educate students about the cultural heritage of Nigeria and Africa.
- Provided support to Hurricane Katrina Victims, Carter Center Guinea Worm Eradication Program, Mercy Foundation, Haiti Earthquake Victims and American Cancer Society.
- Since **2008**, NWAG volunteers annually at MedShare International. NWAG has also volunteered at Atlanta Community Food Bank 2011, 2015-2019 and Foster Care Support Foundation 2012.

- Donated Crocs to children in orphanages in Nigeria in 2014 and 2015, as well as to displaced children in Enugu State, Nigeria in 2015.
